

Join us Monday evenings between 5:30 and 7:00 for the opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation and adore the true presence of Christ on the altar. Benediction is at 7:00 p.m. Please use this opportunity or Saturday afternoon from 3:15-3:45 p.m. as the time to make your Easter Duty since there will be no Penance Services for Easter. The earlier you go, the better since we expect big crowds as we get closer to Holy Week. Remember, if these times are not convenient for you, you may make an appointment for individual confession at anytime by contacting Father at the parish office. Again, Holy Week is quite hectic so do not wait until the last minute. The last formal time for Confessions before Easter will be on Monday, March 25th from 5:30-7:00 p.m.

#### **Lenten Regulations**

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years and older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all \*Fridays of Lent

Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics over the age of 18 to their 60th year. Those bound by this may only take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal practices.

(Those who are ill, pregnant, on medication or special diets for health concerns, or those who work at extremely physical jobs may be exempt from these regulations)
