There will be several chairs set up, Father will wash the 1st person's foot, they will wash the next person's foot, and so on. The entire assembly will be invited to have their foot washed or wash someone's foot. All who wish to participate can come forth at the time they are invited by the Pastor. The Altar Servers and Extraordinary Ministers are especially invited to take part in this service of foot washing.
