

#### **Church Steps and Air Conditioning Update**

Through your tremendous generosity we have raised \$ 56,852 towards the replacement of the front staircase and the air conditioning units. The estimated total cost of the project is \$177,730.

We are going to ask Bishop Bambera for both permission to proceed on these projects and the rest of the money to accomplish our goals. While at first glance, nothing seems to be wrong with the steps, a closer inspections reveals cracks, spaces, missing pieces, and structural problems with the steps. A woman recently caught her heel on one of the spaces and fell on the steps. They are becoming increasingly dangerous. We hope to begin these projects soon. 1/2 of the stairwells will remain open while the other half is being worked on so there should be no disruption to our worship.

Air Conditioning will be replaced as the units have served us well for quite a long time (since the mid 90's) fencing and ladders will be constructed to access the new unit for easier service. A note about **the air:** If you are too cool, sit toward the back of the church where there are no air vents blowing down. If you are too warm, sit closer to the front where more air is circulated. As a rule the temp in the summer should normally be between 72 and 74 degrees in the church. Lower numbers are required when there are more people in church to maintain the room temperature.






