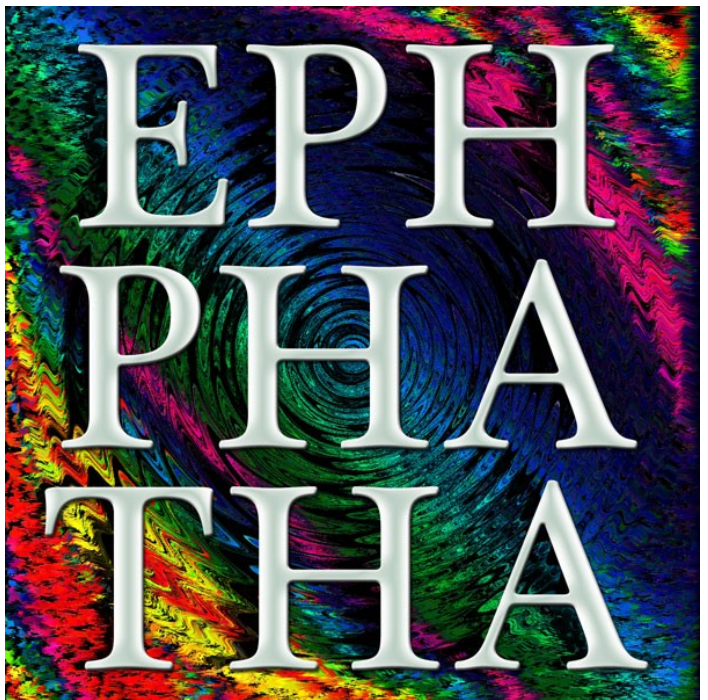

**YOUTH CHOIR**

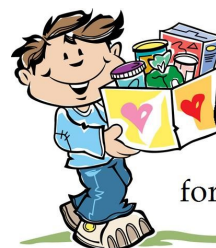

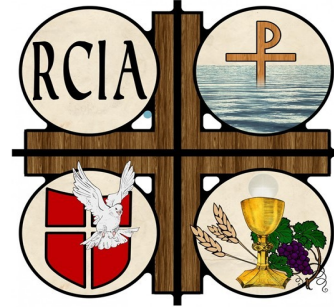
