




23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Many of life's most important lessons come through experience. We live and learn through our successes and mistakes, often discovering the truth about ourselves and others when we least expect it. Experience can open our eyes and our minds to a better understanding and a deeper appreciation of life. That insight can happen in an instant.

When Jesus cures the deaf and mute, it is not simply to restore them to health, but rather to lead them to faith. He opens their ears that they can hear the Gospel and He opens their mouths that they can proclaim what they have heard. Healing is never about Jesus showing His power. It is the power of God, restoring balance and wholeness so that the message of salvation is more apparent and experienced by those healed and by those who witness it.


