#### DRIVE UP CONFESSIONS

You can now confess from the privacy of your car without leaving it, or walk up to the window on the Far Right window of the church (Hall) basement. Hours this week will be from Tuesday, March 16th, 5:30 to 7:00 pm.

Note that confessions will not be heard in the church building at these times but from the driveway only. You can either drive up or walk up to the window.

Church open for private prayer, Tuesday from 5:30-7:00 for Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament.

Please do not park on the right side of the church driveway during confessions so as to allow the traffic to access the window in the door.

You may also request confession at anytime by calling the office and arranging for a time with Father Joe. Because of the pandemic we are only able to offer confession face-to-face.

#### FRIDAY STATIONS AND BENEDICTION

On Fridays during Lent, we will welcome everyone for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 6:30 – 7:00 pm followed by Benediction and Stations of the Cross at 7:00 pm. You may sit throughout the church on Fridays.

#### FRIDAY, MARCH 19th

Please note, this Friday, March 19th is the Solemnity of St. Joseph. The stations of the cross and benediction will *not* be held at 7:00 pm this day. Instead join us at 7pm for a special Eucharist to mark the day during this year of St. Joseph called for by Pope Francis. Our 6:30 am Mass will also be offered.

#### **Blessing of the Easter Baskets**

We will announce the location of the Easter Basket Blessing as we get closer to Easter. It needs to be outside for safety reasons and the weather, of course, must be cooperative for whatever we decided. Plan on 2:00 pm on Saturday, April 3rd, at a location to be announced.


#### Lent/Holy Week and Easter

Thank you for your cooperation and understanding. Church will be open 1/2 hour before services, no earlier.

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

#### Am I excused from fasting and abstinence?

Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also excluded are pregnant or nursing women.




