



REGULATIONS FOR LENT 2025Lent is a 40 day season of prayer, fasting, & almsgiving that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday. It is a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter. The following fasting and abstinence regulations are observed:

Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wed. (March 5, 2025) and Good Friday (April 18, 2025) by all Catholics 18-59.

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 or older. Ash Wed., all Fridays of Lent, & Good Friday are days of abstinence.

How can you spend your time during Lent?

By giving up things you hunger after, such as sweets or alcohol: or activities you desire, such as vacations, concerts, or movies.

By doing things to help others, such as offering an extra donation to the poor or helping those in need by providing food or clothing.

By adding to our normal routine, such as going to daily Mass, praying the Stations of the Cross, and going to Confession.

How do we fast?

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Am I excused from fasting and abstinence?

Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also excluded are pregnant or nursing women
