#### AIR CONDITIONER MALFUNCTION AND WATER DAMAGE

Several weeks ago one of the air conditioner units malfunctioned and now needs to be replaced. (More about the replacement of the units when we get estimates back). However, the malfunction caused damage in the Server's Sacristy. Hymnals were lost, Stations of the Cross, Prayer Booklets had to be tossed out and most notably, the white albs for Extra-ordinary minister of Holy Communion were not salvageable. New albs were ordered and have arrived. Although we will not need EM albs for the foreseeable future as the priest alone is giving out Holy Communion, the new albs will need to be pressed. If someone, or several people would volunteer to press the albs, it would save us from having them professionally done. Also, the Altar Server Cassocks and Surplaces, while not destroyed, need to be laundered and ironed. Again, we are asking for a few volunteers to take them home and wash and iron them. We are not in a hurry for these to be done since this ministry is suspended for now too. If you can help with part of or either of these duties, please contact Lori at the office. Thank you for considering helping us in these duties.


# August 15 Solemnity of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary Parish Outdoor Mass

**NOTICE REGARDING REPORTING SEXUAL ABUSE OF A MINOR** It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee, or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement. It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegations of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator, Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.




