Ushers Meeting

As we continue to welcome more parishioners back to church we want to make sure everyone is on the same page and we have enough coverage to take care of the folks who are coming. All those who are ushers who are currently active and anyone who wishes to lend a hand with the duties are asked to attend a brief but important meeting on Monday, July 13, at 7:00 pm in the church. Please wear a mask and sit socially distanced when you come into the church.

As We Continue to Regather

Just a few notes as some people being or continue to regather with us for Eucharist:

- Masks must be worn at all times while in the church, you slip it off momentarily to receive Holy Communion, and then right back on as you exit the building.
- Upon entrance of the church, hand sanitizer should be used by everyone and you are encouraged to bring your own although stations are available in the church.
- Please enter only through the door marked Entrance, and Exit only through the door marked Exit. These should be open for you as you come in and leave.
- Remember that the obligation is lifted until further notice by the Bishop. There is no need to return to mass especially if you are compromised in anyway physically. Don't take unnecessary risks with your heath.
- On the topic of health...Don't put yourself in danger or anyone else around you in danger of contacting the virus including the priest. If you do not feel well, please stay home. Holy Communion should be taken in the hand. We are in the middle of a global pandemic. You are not only putting yourself at risk, but others and the priest's health in jeopardy by not complying.

Mass in Remembrance of Victims of Violent or Tragic Death

The Diocese of Scranton is offering the annual Mass in remembrance of victims of violent or tragic death. This Mass is offered for the families and friends of those who have died in tragedy, especially through murder, suicide, and accident. This year we keep in our hearts those who lost their struggle with COVID-19.

The Mass is scheduled for **Thursday**, **July 16**, **2020** at **7:00** p.m. in **Saint Peter's Cathedral**, **315 Wyoming**, **Scranton**. All persons who have lost a loved one through tragic and traumatic death are invited to this liturgy. Seating is limited to 70 people. Please call the Office for Parish Life 570-207-2213 ext 1102 to reserve a seat. The mass will be televised on CTV.

We ask that the names of deceased loved ones are registered on registration forms which are available by calling Lori in your parish office (570-287-6624 ext 100) or on the Diocese of Scranton's website, www.dioceseofscranton.org. All forms must be received by July 13, 2020. (If you registered your loved one in previous years, there is no need to register again.)

NOTICE REGARDING REPORTING SEXUAL ABUSE OF A MINOR It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee, or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement. It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegations of sexual abuse of a minor should also be


