Next Sunday December 7th, our parish will pause for A Day of Adoration. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed after the 11:30 a.m. Mass and adoration will continue until 5:15 with Benediction and then the Vigil Mass for the Immaculate Conception at 5:30 pm. DECEMBER 8th HOLY DAY

Next Monday, December 8th is a Holy Day of Obligation for all Catholics, The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Because it falls on a Monday, we will host a special mass on Sunday afternoon that will be in honor of the Holy Day, not a Sunday Obligation Mass. You will need to go to mass twice between Saturday afternoon and Monday evening to fulfill both obligations. If you go on Sunday morning, you may also come Sunday afternoon and receive Holy Communion because it is two different celebrations. THE SACRAMENTS

Baptism

Expecting or new parents are asked to contact the Parish Office as soon as possible to make the arrangements and if necessary, attend the Pre-Baptismal Session. The celebration of the Sacrament is usually held after the 11:30 a.m. Mass on Sundays.

Confirmation

The Sacrament is celebrated for 8th grade students each spring semester. This year Bishop Doughtery will be here on Wednesday, May 6, 2015. Students must be consecutively enrolled in our Parish Religious Education Program or in Catholic Schools to be eligible.

Matrimony

Couples planning to get married are asked to contact the parish office as soon as possible (no less than 6 months prior) to reserve a date and begin the necessary paper work. The dates at the Church are not guaranteed until an actual meeting with the pastor takes place.
