

Raffle and festival information packets are ready and available in the church hall this weekend. Please stop in & pick up your


packet, as well as any homebound family member or neighbor's packet that you are able to deliver.

#### LIFE LINES SCREENING-Monday, June 10th

Do your legs ache after walking a short distance? If so, you may want to consider being screened for peripheral arterial disease (PAD), a condition in which the arteries that carry blood to the arms or legs become narrowed or clogged by plaque, slowing or stopping the flow of blood.
