FROM THE PASTOR

It is hard to believe that there were once, not so long ago, 5 priests serving the Roman Catholics of Swoyersville. With this week's announcement that Father Ed is leaving us, we will be down to a single priest for all of Swoyersville and Forty Fort. We join a long list of towns nearby with only 1 priest or of no priests. Wyoming and West Wyoming share a priest, Plymouth, Larksville, Nanticoke, have only 1 priest assigned for the town.

We ordained 2 men to the priesthood on June 30th, 1

of them will return to school for further studies. We lost 8 men from other countries or other dioceses at the same time. There are no ordinations scheduled for the next 3 years. Given the number of priests who retire each year, the priest who for one reason or another take ill or a leave or absence, the Diocese of Scranton is suffering from a serious lack of priests.

While I cannot accurately predict what Fr. Lyman's departure will mean for our parish, I can say that alterations to schedules will be necessary down the road.

For the month of July we are fortunate to have Fr. Ray Loukashinski, a native son, with us. There will be no change of the mass schedule in July. Beginning August 1st there will be only one daily mass at 8:00AM. We will try to keep the five weekend masses for now on Saturday and Sunday, with help from other priests, unless the attendance or priest availability suggests otherwise.

For now, please keep all priests in your prayers and pray for an abundance of vocations for own Diocese and everywhere there is a shortage of priests now. One thing I know is for sure. We will be depending on you, the lay faithful, to take a more active role in your parish. You may be doing things that only the priest once did. I will address this issue further when time allows. For now, we wish Fr. Ed well in his new assignment and we will be okay here in Swoyersville. Thank you for your support and prayers.
