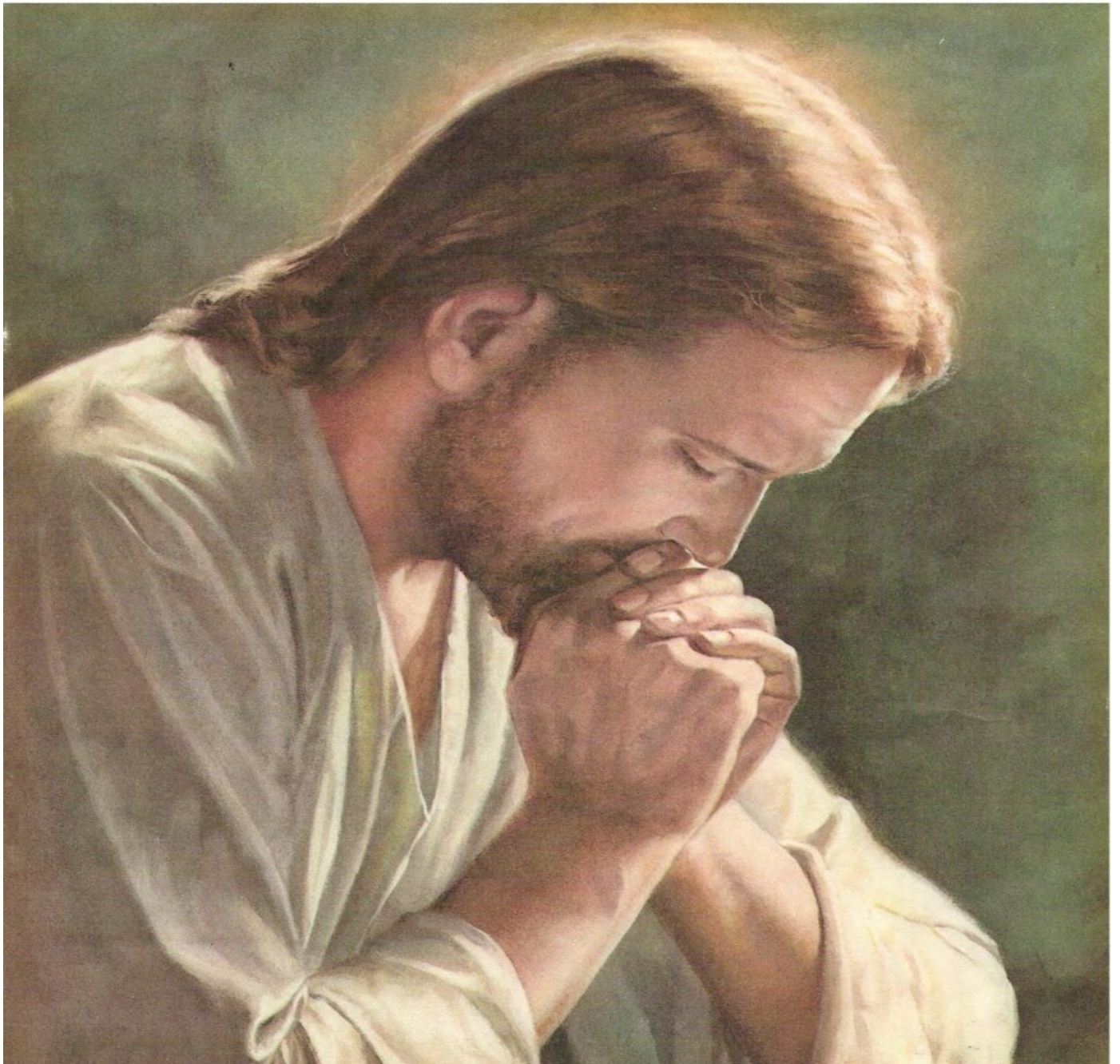

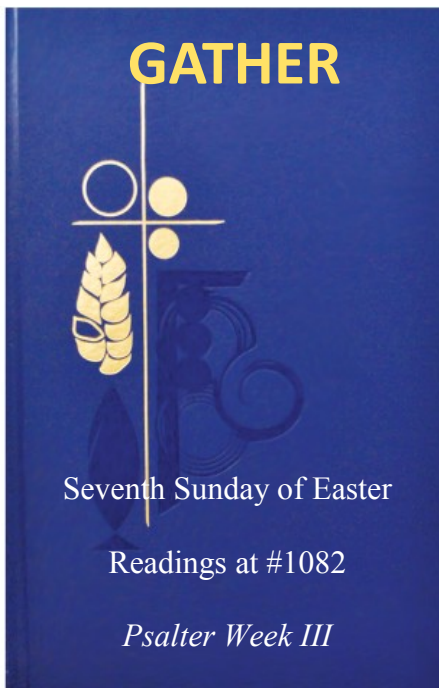

Are you good at Social Media :

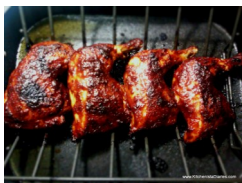
