### SOCIAL CONCERNS COMMITTEE

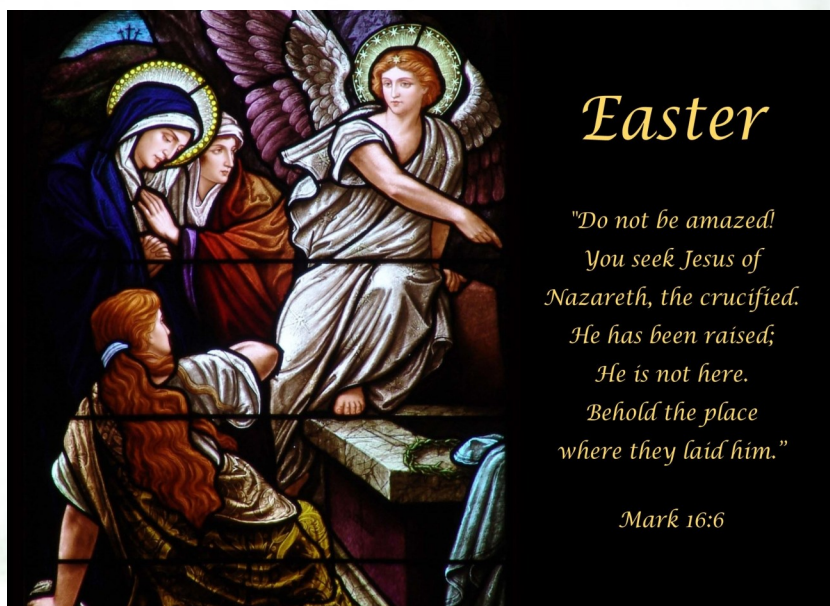
