

Also as the Diocese continues to develop Pastoral Plans for Parishes we need accurate numbers and stats to provide them for discernment of needs. We ask that you take a few moments and fill it out as best you can and get it back to us as soon as possible. Your personal information will kept confidential. Please do not skip the survey. It is also available to downloaded from our homepage for those who may miss the mailing and for those who wish to join or rejoin the parish at this time.

When I originally set the times for the Mass Schedule for the remainder of the corona crisis the thinking was as many masses as possible to avoid overcrowding. Thankfully, we have not had that experience so far at weekend's masses. The vast majority are staying home for now, and that is a good thing for those who are unsure, feel vulnerable because of health concerns or other reasons. I commend you. I know how much you want to be back in the pews and to receive Holy Communion once again. The time will come when that will be a reality. For now, whatever decision you make is the right decision for you. Again, the obligation to attend Eucharist remains lifted until the Bishop declares otherwise. Those of you who are coming know that we are taking extraordinary steps to keep everyone safe with social distancing, cleaning, wearing masks, and the other recommendations made by the CDC and the Diocese of Scranton. The need for the number of people who have been attending masses has been between 25-35 so we do not feel the need to take reservations for Mass at this time. The 7:00 pm Saturday Mass has the lowest attendance and seems unnecessary at this time. We will discontinue the Saturday evening 7:00 Mass. If need arises, we can always put it back in the schedule. For now, the Weekend Schedule will be: Saturday 5:00 pm, (Confessions at 4:30), Sunday 7:00 am, 9:00 am, 11:00 am and **5:30 pm.** It appears these masses can handle the number of people easily during this time of the pandemic. As always, keep safe and healthy. We are praying for everyone. God Bless You,
