



This is above and beyond what Father can do by himself in spiritual direction or advisement.


CONFRATERNITY OF CHRISTIAN MOTHERS

This year, Christmas Eve falls on Sunday. This will impact both the Sunday schedule for that day and the Christmas Eve schedule. For the weekend of December 23 and 24, Regular Sunday Masses for the Obligation of the 4th Sunday of Advent will be at 4 and 5:30 pm Saturday, and Sunday at 8:30 and 10:00 am ONLY. There shall be no 11:30 or 5:30 pm Mass for the 4th Sunday of Advent.

The Schedule for Christmas Vigil and Day, Masses for the Obligation will be Christmas Eve, 4:00, 6:00 and 10:00 pm. *No Midnight Mass this year.*Christmas Day, 8:30 and 11:00 am.

The Regular Weekend Schedule will be followed with all masses on Sunday, day and eve counting for the Obligation of the Solemnity of the Holy Family Sunday. New Year's Day, for those of you who wish to start the New Year with Mass, we will have a 8:30 and 11:00 am for the Solemnity of Mary.


