### Mission Appeal in Our Parish Next Weekend January 8-9

Sister Kathy Kurdziel IHM belongs to the same community as Sister Marion Tarone and Sister Jane Ellis who recently served in this parish. She works as an editor for her community and is also the Delegate for Religious in the Diocese of Scranton. On January 8 and 9, 2022, Sister will make an appeal in the parish for a small mission staffed by the IHM Sisters in the mountains of Peru. Located 11.000 feet above sea level in the beautiful southern Andes Mountains in the small city of Sicuani, the Sisters administer a parish in a poor section of the city where the paved road ends and the mountain paths begin. They do catechesis, pastoral care, sacraments, funeral services, translation, staff a library, a dormitory, and an after school program. The needs are many among the poor shepherds, artisans and subsistence farmers. The IHMs have lived among the people for more than 27 years, tending to their heartaches and celebrating their victories. The mission survives mostly on donations from mission appeals in US parishes. **A second collection will be taken next weekend at all masses for the missions.** Thank you in advance for your cooperation and generosity.




