



Thursday, Feb.3rd, *The Memorial of St. Blaise*, the traditional day for Blessing of the Throats. Individual Blessing of the throats during the 8:00 am Mass. General Blessing of the Throats will be given at this dismissal of masses on the Weekend of 5th and 6th.

Friday, Feb 11th, *Memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes,* also, World Day of the Sick. Communal Anointing of the Sick celebrated during a special 12:10 pm Mass which will take the place of the regular 8:00 am Mass.

Monday, Feb 14th Memorial of *Sts. Cyril and Methodius,* regular daily mass at 8:00 am.

### **RELIGIOUS EDUCATION UPDATES**

Our Children's Faith Formation will continue to be interrupted until at least March 5, 2022, *with the exceptions of our First Communion Classes, grade 2, and our Confirmation Classes, grade 8.* These <u>two Sacramental</u> Grades will resume on February 5, 2022, at the regularly scheduled times. If a parent of a  $2^{nd}$  or  $8^{th}$  grade student decides not to send their child during this time, we kindly ask that you contact Lori Raymond in the main office to arrange with the teacher work to be completed at home. Masks must continue to be worn and no child with **any** symptoms or positive test results from covid will be admitted to class.

Are you peaceful or unsettled when spiritual matters come to your mind? I'd really like to hear from you. You can reply anonymously if you prefer. Thank you so much for taking the time to share your thoughts."


### **Order of Alhambra Scholarship**

In recognition of the increasing importance of education for those with special needs, the International Order of Alhambra announces its scholarship program providing financial aid to students pursuing careers in education for persons with disabilities. The Alhambra Scholarship awards college students studying to teach intellectually and developmentally disabled persons. The scholarships are granted on the basis that applicants are dedicated to the field of special education. The number of scholarships and amounts awarded vary from year to year, based on scholarship program fund levels. The program is open to all eligible U.S. residents. Eligibility guidelines include undergraduate juniors and seniors enrolled in qualifying programs; and master's degree and community college students specializing in special education studies who have accrued half of the required graduation credits. 
