Monday, December 8th, is a Holy Day of Obligation for all Catholics, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Because it falls on a Monday, we will host a special mass this (Sunday) afternoon that will be in honor of the Holy Day, not a Sunday Obligation Mass. You will need to go to mass twice between Saturday afternoon and Monday evening to fulfill both obligations.
