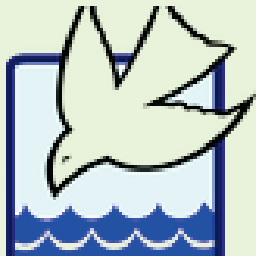

Mission Appeals Next Weekend July 15 & 16

I am thankful to God for the gift of faith, and to you for the generous opportunity to appeal here in the parish on behalf of my home diocese on the World Mission Sunday. My name is Rev. Philbert Takyi-Nketiah from the Diocese of Sunyani, Ghana. I am working in the Diocese of Scranton along with five other priests from Ghana.

We are here because it has become necessary to reciprocate the generosity of the many American missionaries who brought the Catholic Faith to us in Ghana, and helped to nurture its growth to maturity, and we are so glad to do it as diocese and as individual priests. But to be able to continue to offer this needed help, we need more priests. We have more vocation but the high cost of priestly formation in a fragile economy of a developing country like Ghana is so daunting on us as a diocese. That is why we need your financial support on this year's World Mission Appeal.

This year (2023) in July, Bishop Joseph C. Bambera would return to Ghana again to ordain fourteen young men into the priesthood. 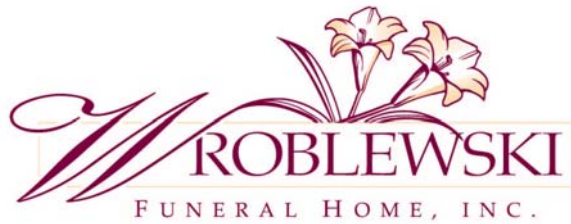
