THE HOLY FATHER WANTS TO HEAR FROM ALL OF US!!!

Landmark Synod Process Begins it's goal is to listen to the whole church even those on the peripheries of the Church. This is a great opportunity and a challenge. We know that the Church must change to meet the needs and problems of our modern world. This approach involves listening to all our hopes and dreams, not just the bishops and cardinals. This process was imagined at Vatican II, and is being realized by our Holy Father now. Watch for Diocesan listening session and parish events to find out how you can contribute to the most important process in the modern church since the 1960's. This is truly a historical moment in the life of the Roman Church.

In Rome — Pope Francis on Oct. 10 officially launched the Vatican's two-year synod process in an opening Mass.

"Everything changes once we are capable of genuine encounters with [Jesus] and with one another, without formalism or pretense, but simply as we are," said Francis in a homily in St. Peter's Basilica. In inaugurating the new process, the pope said the Christian community must reflect the "style of God, who



ristian community must reflect the "style of God, who travels the paths of history and shares in the life of humanity."

This is a "time to look others in the eye and listen to what they have to say, to build rapport, to be sensitive to the questions of our sisters and brothers," Francis said. Francis told delegates not to be afraid to ask questions and to engage in honest, respectful dialogue, while also warning that the synod is not a parliamentary or political process.

"There is no need to create another church, but to create a different church," said Francis, drawing on the words of the influential Dominican theologian Fr. Yves Congar.

"Keep us from becoming a 'museum church,' beautiful but mute, with much past and little future," he pleaded.




