Christmas Mass Schedule

This year's Christmas Mass Schedule is printed on the cover of the Sentinel. It is also being sent home to envelope holders. Please note there will be 2 masses celebrated at 4:00 pm. The Children's Mass in the Church and the Vigil Mass in the School Gym. We needed more room so we moved it to the gym this year. Please note that the gym is **not** handicapped accessible. If you need accessibility, please attend mass in the church and you may want to arrive early as the church usually fills up before 3:30 pm. We will try to reserve the front row and the first row after the break for our handicapped parishioners and friends. Once the church is filled, we kindly ask that everyone proceed to the gym for mass there. Fire codes and regulations must be observed to ensure everyone's safety.

Ushers' Schedule:

Sign up sheets are on the tables at the church entrance: To be sure that all masses are properly covered with ushers, we ask that you kindly sign up for the mass you will be attending on Christmas so we can at least have someone to gather other collectors if needed. We will need ushers for both 4:00 pm masses & upstairs in the church as well.

HELP! We need ushers for 9:00pm mass on Christmas Eve.

HEAT-TRACK MATS

You may have noticed the new mats on the left side of the outside staircase leading to the church. We have installed state-of-the-art Heat Track Mats that will sense when snow or freezing precipitation falls and immediately warms the mats so that they are wet and not snow-covered or slippery. We have had some mishaps on the steps in the past because they are hollow underneath and freeze before the sidewalks. We only did one section of the steps as a trial. If they work, we'll do the rest of the steps at a later time. We ask that when it is snowing or raining, and the temp. is below 35 degrees or so, to use the side of the steps with the Heat Track mats for everyone's safety.



NOTICE REGARDING REPORTING SEXUAL ABUSE OF A MINOR

It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee, or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement. It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegations of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator, Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.
