

Church Hours

Unless permission is revoked our church is open daily from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm for your personal prayers and devotions. Say the rosary, pray the stations of the cross, novena prayers or just visit Jesus in the tabernacle. Please limit it to no more than 10 people at a time in church.

SACRAMENTAL SCHEDULE

Confessions: If it is a matter of urgency, please call Father Joe and make arrangements to meet "outside," in the open air at least 6 feet away.

First Confession and First Holy Communion and Confirmation: will be rescheduled once we return to normal operations.

First Friday and Visits to Homes, Nursing Homes, and Hospitals:

Visits will resume when we get the "all-clear." We do not want to put anyone in danger of getting sick. Sr. Jane and Father will be happy to speak to anyone over the telephone during this time. Please call the rectory and follow the prompts to reach either of them.



With the probability that there shall be no public liturgy for Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday or Easter Sunday, that would include no blessing of the Easter Baskets this year. You may bless your own basket with your family. Here is a version of the blessing.

All Gather and make the sign of the cross. Someone can read: John 6:1-14--Multiplication of the loaves

Leader says the following prayer:

God of glory, the eyes of all turn to you as we celebrate Christ's victory over sin and death.

Bless us and this food of our first Easter meal. May we who gather at the Lord's table continue to celebrate the joy of his resurrection and be admitted finally to his heavenly banquet.

Grant this through Christ our Lord.



NOTICE REGARDING REPORTING SEXUAL ABUSE OF A MINOR

It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee, or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement. It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegations of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator, Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.
