



Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord

This Thursday marks 40 Days since Easter Sunday, the day we hold that Jesus Ascended to the Father. This is a Holy Day of Obligation in the Diocese of Scranton. Our Masses will be on Wednesday (vigil) at 5:30 pm, Thursday at 8:00 am, 12:10 pm and 5:30 pm.

Novena to the Holy Spirit

Beginning on Friday, May 15th, nine days before Pentecost Sunday, we pray in a special way to the Holy Spirit as the disciples of Jesus did as they waited in Jerusalem for the first Pentecost. Please pray a simple prayer as a 9 Day Novena to the Holy Spirit for these nine days until Pentecost Sunday. It can be as simple as saying" "Come Holy Spirit, Come" or the Holy Spirit Prayer: Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created and you shall renew the face of the earth. O God who did instruct the hearts of the faithful by the light of the Holy Spirit, grant us in the same Spirit to be truly wise and ever rejoice in His Consolation. Amen.

Make the novena for yourselves and make it for our parish and our Church that miracles will happen through the Holy Spirit's intercession. This is especially important as we face the challenges of the modern day in our Catholic Church. Pray that the Spirit will lead and guide our leaders and our hearts to a new awakening and understanding of God's Love for us through the Church.

#### THE SACRAMENTS

**Baptism** 

Expecting or new parents are asked to contact the Parish Office as soon as possible to make the arrangements and if necessary, attend the Pre-Baptismal Session. The celebration of the Sacrament is usually held after the 11:30 a.m. Mass on Sundays.

#### Confirmation

The Sacrament is celebrated for 8th grade students each spring semester. This year Bishop Dougherty will be here on Wednesday, May 6, 2015. Students must be consecutively enrolled in our Parish Religious Education Program or in Catholic Schools to be eligible.

#### Matrimony

Couples planning to get married are asked to contact the parish office as soon as possible (no less than 6 months prior) to reserve a date and begin the necessary paper work. The dates at the Church are not guaranteed until an actual meeting with the pastor takes place.
