


SACRAMENTAL LIFE

NATIONAL DAY OF REMEMBRANCE FOR ABORTED CHILDREN

The ninth annual National Day of Remembrance for Aborted Children will be held on Saturday, Sept. 18 when pro-life Americans will honor the memory of the nearly 61 million unborn victims of abortion since its legalization in 1973. The event on Sept. 18 will include a Memorial Service for Victims of Abortion to be held at 11 a.m. at Mount Olivet Cemetery, 612 Mount Olivet Road, Carverton. The pro-life gathering will take place at Mount Olivet, Wyoming Valley Knights of Columbus, Tomb for the Unborn, located on the top of the hill on the cemetery grounds. During the memorial observance, the Rosary will be recited in remembrance of all aborted babies. All faithful are invited.

Hello! I am Sister Mary Beth Makuch, a member of the Sisters of Saints Cyril and Methodius. A native of Wilkes-Barre, my parents Paul and Catherine Swatkoski Makuch, were members of Saint Joseph's Slovak Church in the Heights section of Wilkes Barre. It was there that my brother, Paul Stephen, and I received our Sacraments and experienced the blessings of a wonderful worshipping community.

After graduating from Marymount High School, I entered the Congregation of the Sisters of Saints Cyril and Methodius in Danville, PA. 
