Holy Week Notes:

- Next Sunday, is Palm Sunday. We will bless palms at the beginning of each mass at the entrance of the church. We ask that you do not talk palm branches into the church with you so that they may all be blessed in the beginning of mass. You may take your palm as you exit the church.
- The Passion Gospel will be read by two lectors and the priest this year. There will not be a part that needs to be called out by the assembly. You are invited to follow the Passion reading in the Gather Hymnals for Palm Sunday and Good Friday.
- For Holy Saturday, we will bless the fire and the paschal candle this year in front of the church so that everyone may see it being done. The wind, and weather are dangerous for the fire to be outside and no one really can see what is going on. Hopefully this will work out better for us.
- Note there will be reserved seating for the Easter Vigil for those who will be baptized, confirmed and receiving Holy Eucharist. There is no 4:30 mass on April 20th, only the 8:00 pm Easter Vigil. There will be no confessions Saturday afternoon.
- We will need help decorating the church Easter Saturday morning at about 9:30 am. Please come and lend a hand for however long you can spare. Men will be needed to climb ladders and carry and lift heavy objects.


