


#### **2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time**



#### Parish Finances

Dear Parishioner,

As we start a new year you may have noticed the increase offering suggestion for monthly dues has gone from \$8.00 to \$10.00. I want to be absolutely clear. No one should fear that they will not have access to services from our Parish if dues are not paid as long as I am your pastor. Upon my arrival, I wanted to get rid of "dues," but was told no to do it and I have found the dues absolutely help us make our parish obligations each month. But the thought of someone being turned away from the Anointing of the Sick, A Funeral, A Baptism or any other service is because dues are not paid is not what we are about here at Seton. Any and All Catholics are entitled to whatever is possible to give them from the church regardless of contributions. Now we need your support in order to continue our mission and ministry. As far as I can tell, "dues," were once a way to make sure people supported the church minimally each year so that it could remain open. This is a minimalistic approach and should not be used by churches today. Giving should come from the heart, not by force and the amount should be based entirely on what each is "able," to give. So if the \$10 a month is too much for you, give what you are able. In the coming months, as you noticed in last week's bulletin, the Diocese of Scranton will direct us to address finances with you much more in detail. More on that in February. Meanwhile, no one should feel forced into giving what they cannot afford. And as far as membership in our parish, we have some who are "on the books," but anyone who needs us is a member of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish. We are here to serve you to the best of our ability whether you are on the books or not! P.S. Being on the books is vital to our parish remaining stable.


