FESTIVAL CLEAN-UP


Starting Sunday after all masses we need help dismantling under the tent. Please help if you can. The area must be cleared by Monday morning for the men to remove the tent from the grounds.

Finances

We are responsible for the proper insurances on all of our property, vehicles, buildings, boilers, workmens comp., etc. as is every other institution. We receive our insurance balance due for the period of July 1, 2012 to July 1, 2013. The total premium due is \$41,160.00 for that time period.

Our annual parish assessment from the Diocese of Scranton, not including the school assessment is \$42,060.00 for the 2012 –2013 fiscal year.

It is quite expensive to run a parish of this size. We are thankful for your weekly generosity and spirit of stewardship. Without it, we could not begin to cover our expenses. Thank you for all that you do!

Due to the early deadline for the bulletin, collections from last week will be listed one week later. Next week's bulletin will list the collection from July 8th.

In order for us to cash checks, they must be made out to St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish. All checks addressed otherwise shall be returned.

assembly has to finish the liturgy it begins. The cast doesn't slip out to the party until the curtain call (unless it's a really awful production). The timpanist doesn't leave the stage just because she's not playing in the final bars of the symphony. The team doesn't leave the gym until the final buzzer or the last out. At Mass, you are every bit as essential to the action as any musician, actor, or team member. It is a simple act of kindness to finish the liturgy before leaving. After all, we have just become what we have received, the presence of Christ in the world. Why not savor the energy that comes from being in such good company for a bit? Maybe when we learn to relish and not rush the end of things, we will start savoring the best parts of life, not rushing through meals, going for a leisurely walk, taking time to linger over a cup of coffee or sit by a sickbed telling stories of the blessings of days gone by.
