

CTV reaches more than 235,000 homes, hospitals, and nursing facilities broadcasting the daily Mass and many other faith-based programs. The Diocesan website is an excellent online resource for information about life and events in the Diocese, including videos of the daily Mass and the special liturgies celebrated at St. Peter's Cathedral and Bishop Bambera's homilies.

A confession: Sometimes I feel as if I am in the middle of a horse race at Pocono Downs. Wow! Our Parish has lots of things going on and they come and go fast! Don't get me wrong, it's all good stuff, very positive and faith affirming, but for one priest, it can be like running a marathon. I share this with you because I do not see an end to the activity anytime soon. We are in a phase of "rebuilding." That takes lots and lots of hard work by many people. It also takes lots and lots of PRAYER by all of us. And I know this is a community of prayer! Father Urban tells us he would have never made it through his latest health crisis if it were not for our prayers: "I can feel the Spirit and your constant prayers for me." Baptism
