

TRYING TO EXPRESS THE INEXPRESSIBLE TRINITY SUNDAY

The Great Mystery of the Christian Faith is our belief in the Triune God. One Deity or God, yet Three Persons in the One God? Yes, scratch our heads we should... While we will never fully understand this mystery. sometimes it is helpful to turn to art or music to express that which is inexpressible. The cover of our bulletin today is an icon, popular in the Eastern Tradition of the church. It depicts three identical, but differently clad heavenly figures. The differences in the clothing may express the "three" persons. The identical facial appearance express the unity of God. All are seated around a table with a chalice at the center. While it is best to let our imagination play out the story, the more common title for this icon is the Old Testament Trinity. It is taken from the story of the three angels that visited Abram in the Old Testament. While Abram and the Jewish people did not understand God as a Trinity of Persons, Christians may look back on the story as a pre-figuring or foreshadowing of the New Testament understanding of the Triune God. No matter what our individual icons of the Trinity look like, let us adore the One God in Three Divine Persons today and everyday of our lives. As we sing today: Praise the Holy Trinity, Undivided Unity! Holy God! Mighty God! God Immortal Be Adored!

JUNE 22nd, CORPUS CHRISTI SUNDAY

On Sunday June 22nd, the Universal Church will celebrate Corpus Christi Sunday, the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. You may recall that our first Sunday together as a new parish was back in 2012 on the Solemnity of Corpus Christi. We have then two very important reasons to celebrate on this day. Let's come together for our regular celebrations of the Eucharist this weekend and have a period of Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament (with perhaps an outdoor procession if weather permits) after the 11:30 a.m. Mass until 5:30 p.m. We will conclude the day with Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament and a Special Mass at 5:30 p.m. All are most welcome to attend some or all of this day of prayer. We will need people to sign-up for the Adoration on Sunday afternoon so that our Sacred Lord is not left alone on the altar. Please see the forms at the entrance of the Church. Let's worship our Eucharistic Savior this day by making it a solemn occasion of adoration and praise. Families are encouraged to bring their children for even a brief period of adoration so that they may be exposed to this awesome tradition of the Church.
