

#### VISION 2030 in Our Deanery.

As most of us are aware, the Diocese of Scranton is experiencing tremendous populations shifts, declining church membership and support and a quickly diminishing number of active priests to serve parishes. As facts and figures are calculated, adjustments to parishes are occurring. In our Kingston Deanery, there will be two new linkages of parishes this summer: St. Ignatius (Kingston) and Holy Family (Luzerne) will share 1 pastor and St. Johns (Larksville) and All Saints (Plymouth) will also share 1 pastor for the 2 parishes. Presently linked parishes already include Nanticoke and Lake Silkworth and Dallas and Harvey's Lake (both linkages are in our deanery.) This process is by no means complete, it will continue to address the changing needs of out deanery and diocese as needs arise and changes occur. Mass Schedules will be affected at these two newest linkages so please check the times if you plan on worshiping with those communities. These two linkages are very close to our own parish so overlapping of attendance is sure to occur. Please pray for our own parish, the Kingston Deanery and the Diocese of Scranton during this time of change and adjusting. This process is not a one and done deal. It will continue to be workedout as the diocese tries to serve its people the best way possible.


