
HOLY NAME SOCIETY will meet next Sunday, September 8th, after the 8:30am Mass in the church hall. New members are always welcome.

#### HOLY NAME-ST. MARY'S BUILDING


We are making the final preparations for the razing of the former Holy Name-St. Mary's structure. The original bell with the names of the founding families has been removed from the church and is going to be placed at St. Mary's Cemetery, near the chapel. The building



is scheduled to come down next week, the week of September 9th. For everyone's safety, we ask that you do not approach the site during the working hours. When the area is stable and safe, you may retrieve a brick if you wish. All religious items have been long taken out of the building with the exception of the Stations of the Cross which were attached to the wall and no one wanted because no matter how carefully they were removed, damage was done to them. We are going to make the damaged stations available to our parishioners rather than destroy them. There are 14 Stations. We will take the names of people who wish to have one, (to be treasured as a very religious item, not put on ebay). This is for current parishioners of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton only and we ask for a donation of some sort to help defray the cost of removal of the stations. Call the rectory this Tuesday, September 3rd from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. if you would like your name in the drawing. The 1st 14 names that are pulled will have the corresponding number of station. Unfortunately, we cannot accept requests for a particular station unless we have less than 14 people interested. You must call during business hours only on this Tuesday, September 3rd.
