

Religious Education is set to begin...Classes for grades 1-8 resume on Saturday, September 17th and Monday, September 19th. All students who are not enrolled in Catholic Schools must be registered in our Religious Education Program. Only those students who are consecutively enrolled in the CCD program will be eligible for First Holy Communion and Confirmation. It is the parent or guardian 's responsibility to make sure that all baptized children are being educated in the faith. 

A reminder to all parishioners: If you or a family or friend is admitted to the Hospital, Physical Rehab, or a Nursing Home, please contact Sister Jane at 570-763-5160 to inform the parish. We try to visit everyone we know is hospitalized or in a facility for any length of time but we need your help. Hospitals do not release patient information to the parish any longer due to privacy regulations. For emergency Anointing of the Sick, call anytime, day or night the main rectory number for assistance. Note that priests are assigned to hospital emergency calls on a rotating basis so ask the nurses station to call the priest on duty in the event of an emergency.
