

PRO LIFE RALLY JANUARY 22ND

In lieu of organizing Buses to the Washington March for Life, this year Pennsylvanians for Human Life will sponsor a prolife rally commemorating the 48th anniversary of Roe vs Wade to be held at City View Park, 700 South Poplar Street, Hazleton, Pa., on Friday January 22nd at 12 noon. All are welcome to attend. Key speaker for the event, author Starr Rogers, will talk about her 4 abortions and her journey to now defend the unborn. Starr will be accompanied by her son, Matt Finney, who represents siblings of those who have lost brothers or sisters to abortion. The venue offers several large covered pavilions, tables and benches. CoVid precautions will be in place. Bob's BBQ food truck will be on site from 11 a.m. After the Rally, the group will proceed to Hazleton's St Gabriel's Cemetery Memorial to the Unborn Child to pay tribute to 64 million babies who have died due to abortion.






