

Celebrating our Future, Honoring Our Past

We are constructing a memorial to all three churches that make up St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish. The cornerstones from Holy Name of Jesus and St. Mary's Churches will be on display next to the cornerstone of Holy Trinity Church. Also the original bell from St. Mary's with the founder's names engraved on it will be part of the display honoring our past. On the opposite side, to Celebrate our Future, a sculpture of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton is being made and should be here by the end of October. The new displays will feature paver bricks which can be engraved by parishioners and friends with their names, family names, or in remembrance of past family members and parishioners. The forms for the bricks are in this week's Sentinel, on page 4. Return your completed form with payment to the rectory. There is also an opportunity to dedicate a bench near the statue and also the Statue of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, for dedication or memorial. They can be quite costly, so be prepared if you are interested in having the statue or the bench in your name or in memory of someone. Contact Monica at the office for cost estimates.

PROPERTIES UP FOR BID

The Finance Council of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish is offering once again, the two remaining properties from Holy Name-St. Mary's. The former convent at 14 Barber Street and the former rectory at 283 Shoemaker Street. The Finance Council will take the highest bid over \$35,0000.00 for the Barber Street property, and the highest bid over \$200,000 for the Shoemaker Street address. Subject to parish and diocesan approval. The successful bidder will need to seal the bid and have it turned into the Seton Parish Rectory at 116 Hughes Street by October 31st at noon. No deposit is required but it would be expected that the highest bidder can come up with the funds in a timely fashion as agreed upon with the council. MEMORIAL/DONOR PAVERS
