## *Monday. May 29th Mary, Mother of the Church and Memorial Day*

Pope Francis has declared that the Monday after Pentecost to be a day to honor, Mary, Mother of the Church. This year that Monday is also a National Holiday, Memorial Day. We will be joined by members of the VFW and other civic organizations for our Memorial Day Eucharist at 9:00am on Monday. We will observe the memorial of the Church and celebrate the holiday of our nation as well. Mary, under the title of Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception is the patroness of America, therefore it is fitting to honor Mary as we pray for our deceased military members. As we pray every day, “Holy Mary, mother of God, pray for us now and at the Hour of our Death. Amen.” Come celebrate this day with us at Eucharist!



It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement.



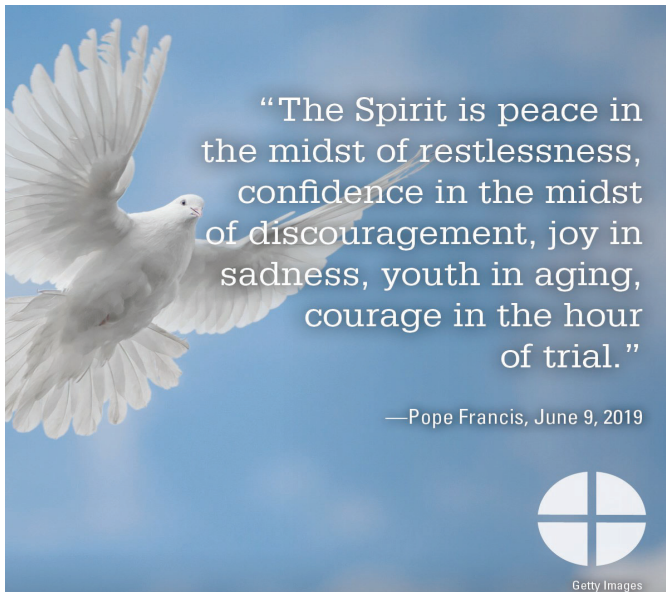
It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour Child Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at [www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis](http://www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis). To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.
