

Holy Week begins next weekend with Palm Sunday. Please take palm branches on the way into mass to have them blessed at the beginning of mass. While most COVID-19 restrictions have been lifted the following will remain in place for us this year. Holy Thursday— no foot washing and no distribution of the common communion chalice, sacred hosts will be distributed as usual. Good Friday—no kissing or touching the cross at the Veneration and the Dead Christ statue after mass. Masks may continued to be worn by choice.

Easter Sunday Masses—For the Children, the Bunny promises to visit Fr. Joe and Sebastian and leave a small Easter Treat for our youngsters! Make sure the children look for wherever they may appear at the end of masses on Easter Sunday.




