

WEEKDAY EUCHARIST NEW TIME

We are still under all of the norms for the COVID-19 Epidemic which means, you may arrive 15 min before mass, no earlier...Masks must be worn...Social Distancing and Hand Sanitization...Exit right after the mass with the distribution of Holy Communion. And there will be no public devotions before or after mass, this includes Novenas, Rosary and Friday Devotions. Please pray these privately on your own.

Temporary Weekday Masses:

Hearing from many who depend on an earlier weekday mass due to work or school, we will maintain the 6:30 AM Weekday Eucharist (*for the time being*) on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday, & *also add* an 8:00am Mass on those

Wednesday mass will be ONLY davs. at 8:00 am. (St. Nicholas, in Wilkes-Barre has a 6:30 am Mass on Wednesday). While this is a change in what we have planned, and masses may need to be cancelled (or rescheduled) from time to time because of a lack of priests able to fillin at that hour, we want to make the Daily Eucharist accessible to those who work early. So beginning this Monday, masses will be at 6:30 am and 8:00am on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday; and 8:00 am for Wednesday only. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding With the continuation of the pandemic, all things are subject to change at any time.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION OF CHILDREN

All teachers must have current clearances and documentation on file with the parish.

LIFE LINE SCREENING AT SETON


Day of Remembrance for Aborted Children

The Diocese of Scranton will participate in the eighth annual National Day of Remembrance for Aborted Children on Saturday, Sept. 12 when pro-life Americans will honor the memory of the nearly 60 million unborn victims of abortion since its legalization in 1973. Diocesan observances on Sept. 12 will include a Memorial Service for Victims of Abortion to be held at 11 a.m. at Mount Olivet Remembrance Day for Abortion Victims Cemetery, 612 Mount Olivet Road, Carverton. The pro-life gathering will take place at Mount Olivet's Wyoming Valley Knights of Columbus "Tomb for the Unborn," located on the top of the hill on the cemetery grounds. During the memorial observance, the Rosary will be recited in remembrance of all aborted babies. All faithful are invited.



NOTICE REGARDING REPORTING SEXUAL ABUSE OF A MINOR It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee, or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement. It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegations of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator, Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.




